Creator: Wand, Jessie Ziegler, 1901-1991

Biographical sketch:

Jessie Ziegler Wand (b. Jessie D. Ziegler), also known as Jessie Ziegler Burch, was a secretary and reporter. She worked as a newspaper reporter in Houston, Texas and was a member of the Women's Advertising Club of Houston before moving to Austin, Texas. She served as secretary for Governor Ross S. Sterling, State Senator H. Grady Woodruff, the Texas Highway Department, and the Texas Petroleum Council before her marriage to McAfee Wayland Burch in 1933. They divorced, and she married Lester H. Wand in 1940.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of a copy of a newspaper clipping and a letter collected by Jessie Wand. The news article is about divisions in the Democratic Party and the Supreme Court over New Deal legislation. The letter is from J. J. "Jake" Pickle and recommends Wand donate the article to the Lyndon B. Johnson Library and Museum.
