O. J. Weber was a Texas attorney who served as an administrative assistant and office manager for then Congressman Lyndon B. Johnson.

This collection consists of papers collected by O. J. Weber that are related to his work as an administrative assistant and office manager for then Congressman Lyndon B. Johnson. The papers contain a letter from Johnson to Weber written soon after Weber had resigned to join the Army. In the letter, Johnson gives advice for Weber to be successful. There is also a much later letter from Weber to Lady Bird Johnson describing his experiences working for Lyndon B. Johnson
