Biographical sketch:

Thomas Sydney Edwards, also known as T. S. Edwards (b. May 2, 1875, Navasota, Texas-d. April 24, 1964, Knox City, Knox County, Texas), was a physician in Knox City, Texas. He married Alma Taylor Roger in 1912 and they had a son, Tom Rogers Edwards. He is interred in Knox City Cemetery in Knox City, Texas.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Thomas S. Edwards, a friend of Lyndon B. Johnson and his relatives. The papers consist of correspondence, newspaper clippings, and short informational publications. The correspondence is between Dr. Edwards and Johnson.
