Biographical sketch:

Frederick O'Reilly Hayes was an economist who worked for the New York State government in finance jobs for three years before taking a position as an economist at the Bureau of the Budget. He later worked as budget director for New York and as a public policy and management issues consultant.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, speeches, reports, and other publications from Frederick O'R. Hayes's work at the Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) and the Urban Renewal Administration (URA). The material deals primarily with the Community Action Programs and the War on Poverty. There are also later publications that deal with his work on anti-poverty programs.
