Scope and content note:

This collection consists of files created by Pierre Salinger while he served as Press Secretary to President Lyndon B. Johnson. The files contain correspondence, reports, press releases, schedules and lists. They include materials on departments and agencies, particularly the United States Information Agency; reports from meetings; and materials distributed to the press. Major topics include foreign relations, particularly Cuban efforts to cut off water to the U.S. Navy base at Guantanamo Bay, atomic energy, postal issues, labor-management relations, public works, and legislation.
