Part II Biographic/Administrative Note

The Cabinet Papers consist of material brought together from various parts of the Johnson Library's collections, including 14 boxes labeled "Cabinet Meetings," 2 boxes labeled "Cabinet Review," 2 boxes labeled "Cabinet Meeting Material from Cabinet Safe on 4th Floor," and 1 box of miscellaneous items with a 1/10/69 memorandum by Charles M. Maguire attached to the outside. Most of the documents originally were collected and filed by aides who served as secretaries to the Cabinet--Horace Busby, who assumed the post in January 1965 (there seems to have been no Cabinet secretary from 11/63-12/64), Robert E. Kintner, who held the job from April 1966 through June 1967, and Charles M. Maguire, who took over in mid-1967 and continued through the end of the Administration.

Although the presidential Cabinet is a well-established American institution, its uses and powers vary from administration to administration. As late in the Johnson Administration as September 12, 1967, Charles Maguire and Douglass Cater sent a memorandum to the President recounting a White House staff discussion of the purpose and past success of Cabinet meetings (the memo may be found in the material on the 9/20/67 meeting). The Johnson Cabinet rarely debated policy; a May 14, 1968, debate on the budget was so unusual as to merit special mention. Cabinet meetings under Johnson generally served as a means of informing the secretaries of developments in other agencies so that all departments could support the whole range of the Administration's domestic and foreign programs and policies. There was much discussion of pending legislation and how to move it through Congress, and of housekeeping in the federal government, including topics such as savings bond drives, cost-cutting innovations, and hiring practices.
