PERSONAL PAPERS OF HAROLD BROWN

Creator: Brown, Harold, 1927-

Biographical sketch:

Harold Brown was a research scientist who served as the Director of the Lawrence Livermore Laboratory in California. He was a member of the President's Scientific Advisory Committee and was director of research and engineering at the Department of Defense. From 1965 to 1969 he served as the Secretary of the Air Force under President Johnson. He served as President of California Institute of Technology, was a U.S. delegate to SALT (Strategic Arms Limitations Talks), and was chairman of the Technology Assessment Advisory Council to U.S. Congress. Brown served as Secretary of Defense under President Carter.

This collection consists of photographs, scrapbooks and mementoes reflecting Harold Brown's service to the Department of Defense and as Secretary of the Air Force.
