Biographical sketch:

Curtis Gans was a political activist and expert on voting patterns in the United States. He was one of the founders of the 'Dump Johnson" movement and Operations Director for the 1968 Presidential campaign of Eugene V. McCarthy.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, reports, publications, speeches, research papers, press releases, and newspaper clippings collected by Curtis B. Gans covering the "Dump Johnson" movement, campaigns, and elections, as well as a manuscript that Gans was writing on his own experiences. The papers include speeches and campaign materials from Senator Eugene McCarthy's campaigns along with materials on anti-war protests, opposition to Lyndon B. Johnson, voting laws, and political groups such as the Coalition for a Democratic Alternative and Americans for Democratic Action.
