Biographical sketch:

William Martin Blackburn (b. 1939) was Staff Assistant to President Lyndon B. Johnson, from 1967 to 1969. After leaving the White House, he served as a lawyer in private practice.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, reports, publications, press releases, and newspaper clippings related to William M. Blackburn's service as staff assistant to President Lyndon B. Johnson. The papers include materials concerning congressional relations, legislation, White House and executive branch staffing, government travel, executive agency operations and issues, the 1968 presidential campaign, and the 1969 presidential transition. Specific topics include immigration, physical fitness, budgeting, contracting, and the disposition of government property.
