Biographical sketch:

Donald S. Gilpatric worked for the Board of Economic Welfare from 1942 to 1943 and the State Department from 1943 to 1945. He was also director of the China Relief Mission and economic advisor to Allied Force Headquarters in Algeria. He became a Foreign Service Officer, and served as the Director of the Office of Foreign Commercial Services at the Department of Commerce from 1962 until his retirement in 1981.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, reports, publications, and mementoes collected by Donald S. Gilpatric that are related to his professional activities in the Department of State and Department of Commerce; the development, organization, activities, and evolution of the Office of Foreign Commercial Services; efforts to improve United States markets overseas; as well as materials on diplomacy, international economic integration; and international trade.
