Creator: Horn, Stephen John, 1931-

Biographical sketch:

Stephen John Horn served as an administrative assistant to Secretary of Labor James P. Mitchell, as a Congressional assistant to Senator Thomas H. Kuchel, Dean of Graduate Studies and Research at The American University in Washington, D.C., and President of California State University, Long Beach. He served as the U.S. Representative for California's 38th District from 1993 to 2003.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Stephen Horn mainly related to his service as a Congressional assistant. The materials include a periodic log kept by Mr. Horn during the time surrounding the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that documents many of the strategy meetings related to the legislation. The papers also contain reports, speeches, newsletters, notes, and articles related to civil rights legislation.
