Harold W. Horowitz was a law school professor and served as a Vice Chancellor at the University of California Los Angeles. He worked as an associate general counsel for the Department of Health Education and Welfare and served as Deputy General Counsel for the McCone Commission.

This collection consists of drafts of legislation, correspondence, and reports created by Harold Horowitz covering his work as an associate general counsel for the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare; and his service on the President's Task Force on the War Against Poverty. The papers are heavily annotated by hand and are related to the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964.
