

SUBJECT: Alternatives to US Facilities in Pakistan

I have reviewed your 22 October 1965 Memorandum to me in response to NSAM 337 as updated by the Department of State's 17 May 1966 Memorandum to Mr. Rostow and by my approval on 23 May of the new military sales package for Iran.

I approve your recommendations as updated subject to the usual review by the Bureau of the Budget before expenditures are authorized.
