Creator: Shriver, Sargent, 1915-2011

Biographical sketch:

Robert Sargent Shriver, brother-in-law of John F. Kennedy, was a lawyer, businessman, government official, and diplomat. He served as the Director of the Peace Corps, Director of the Office of Economic Opportunity, and Special Assistant to President Lyndon B. Johnson. Shriver later served as Ambassador to France, was a Vice Presidential candidate in 1972, and a Presidential candidate in 1976.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of a photocopy of the National Anti-Poverty Plan for 1968-1972 submitted by Shriver, Office of Economic Opportunity, to Charles L. Schultze, Bureau of the Budget. This document defines a 10 year War on Poverty action plan to end United States poverty by the year 1976 through job growth, social programs, health programs, and income assistance.
