Subject: Appointment for President Mutesa of
Uganda with President Johnson

President Johnson has agreed in principle to visit with Heads of State who come to the United States to visit the World's Fair. We are advised that President Sir Edward Frederick Mutesa of Uganda is coming to the United States for Africa Day May 21 and then wants to come to Washington to meet President Johnson.

We believe that the morning of May 25, would be most satisfactory in light of President Johnson's known schedule. We request therefore that if convenient, a specific time for the meeting be established on May 25.

Prime Minister states GOU considering accepting this invitation and requests this Embassy determine whether it possible to arrange at this late date for President of Uganda pay courtesy call on President Johnson on any day from May 25 through May 27. At present tentative ETA for President of Uganda arrive New York is May 19.

Prime Minister regretted short notice in submitting request pay courtesy call on President Johnson. If trip develops as it now appears certain recommend arrangements for short courtesy call on President Johnson. I will make clear to Prime Minister that trip will not take on any aspects of state visit.

To avoid misunderstandings here Embassy would appreciate advice whether transportation of President of Uganda and party as well as other expenses being borne by World's Fair Corporation or Uganda or whatever portion will be shared.
