Scope and content note:

Civil Aviation contains files concerning aviation, general and commercial. This includes material on aviation accidents, airports, rates, routes and navigation, safety and traffic control, subsidies, and Civil Aeronautics Board cases and decisions.

Related material may be found in FG 226 (Federal Aviation Agency), FG 718 (President's Advisory Committee on the Supersonic Transport), and ND 1 (National Defense - Military Aviation). The files of White House Aides Ernest Goldstein (Travel and Balance of Payments), Harry McPherson (International Aviation), and DeVier Pierson (CAB decisions) also contain civil aviation related material.

CA CIVIL AVIATION

Contains memorandum and correspondence dealing with general aspects of civil aviation. Important topics covered include the Supersonic Transport Program, with material on the Black-Osborne Report, progress and interim reports on the program, technical developments, public reaction to the SST, sonic booms and noise tests, President's Advisory Committee on the Supersonic Transport, financial participation by the airlines, Senate votes on SST, program delays, and support for program given by local governments; the sonic boom problem with material on the Oklahoma City and Edwards Air Force Base testing programs; the jet noise problem at airports, particularly John F. Kennedy and National Airports.

Other topics include the question of jet usage of National Airport; material on airport development, construction, and financing; reports on the status of the aviation industry including the employment situation and balance of payments problems. There are some references to international negotiations and agreements including those with Colombia, Mexico, Japan, Canada, the Soviet Union, and the Republic of South Africa. There are documents discussing Civil Aeronautics Board cases. There is substantial material relating to the International Congress on Air Technology. There are references to Federal Government administrative use of aircraft and of possible government aircraft pooling. 14 1/2".

CA 1 ACCIDENTS

(opened 4/74)

Box 4

Material pertaining to aircraft accidents, civilian, military, and international. There are reports on accidents; condolence messages, including those from foreign heads of state; explanations to relatives of casualties; and citizen advice on avoiding aircraft accidents. There is a small amount of documents dealing with the plane crash involving Senators Birch Bayh and Edward Kennedy. 1".

CA 2 AIRPORTS

Boxes 4-5

Documents concerning airports and airport development. Specific airports mentioned are Dallas-Fort Worth, Dulles, National, Chicago Midway, Houston Intercontinental, a fourth New York City airport, Bolling-Anacostia, Beltsville Agricultural Airport, Cable Airport (California), the Lower Rio Grande Valley airport case, Anchorage International, and Alaskan airports. There is also material on a Washington, D. C., heliport. There are documents on federal aid to airports, the Airports and Airways Program, the Airports Task Force, the flight service stations, airport noise, and airport safety. Material on changes in customs inspection procedures at Kennedy International is also found in this category. 3".

Material relating to aviation subsidies, particularly helicopter subsidies for New York, Chicago and Los Angeles. -1".
