Scope and content note:

This series contains the working files of Liz Carpenter during her time as Lady Bird Johnson's Press Secretary and Staff Director. The material in this series includes correspondence, memorandums, newspaper clippings, press releases, photographs, lists, menus, telegrams, schedules, maps, reports, and drafts related to the duties of Liz Carpenter, including managing the activities of the First Lady and her daughters, Luci Baines Johnson and Lynda Johnson Robb.

Some of these activities include travel, entertaining foreign visitors, State Dinners, receptions, presentations, campaigning, dedications, luncheons, and other events. In addition, the files also contain material related to Lady Bird Johnson's beautification efforts, such as tree and flower plantings done in the Washington, D.C. area; her trips to highlight education, the poverty program, beautification, national parks, and cultural sites; the Whistle Stop Campaign for the 1964 Presidential election; and Women Doer's Luncheons hosted by Lady Bird Johnson. The series also includes drafts and other material related to speeches written by Liz Carpenter.
