Scope and content note:

The subject "Housing" is used for material pertaining to the approval of programs developed by local communities for the prevention and elimination of slum and blight conditions, including urban renewal; housing trends; certification of maximum number and administering disaster relief activities relating to housing and community facilities.

Subcategories:

HS HOUSING.

> Pertains to the housing activities in the United States including frequent reports on the number of housing starts, suggestions for housing to benefit the lower income groups, and progress in technology. Also included are letters revealing discrimination in some areas, personal problems with fraudulent practices.

HS₁ COLLEGE.

Concerns college housing, mostly pertaining to the moratorium on

college housing loan applications since 1/31/66

HS 2 PUBLIC HOUSING PROGRAM

> Pertaining to efforts made in providing adequate housing for all Americans including the problems confronted, such as financing, contract letting, land availability, legislative approval, complaints, and priority

cases. Also includes the turnkey projects and rent supplements

HS 3 **URBAN RENEWAL - SLUM CLEARANCE**

Pertains to plans for slum clearance with efforts to involve the business

HS 3/FG 216 URBAN RENEWAL - SLUM CLEARANCE /WASHINGTON, D.C.

Pertains to the urban development progress and needs in Washington, D.C. including Project I Fort Lincoln and the Shaw re-development area, and the group DOWNTOWN PROGRESS

HS 3/ST URBAN RENEWAL - SLUM CLEARANCE /STATES

Contains much correspondence relating to land used for urban renewal. The material is filed by the state involved in the controversy or comment.

HS 4 VETERANS

Pertains to housing for veterans including loans and lending rates, housing production, financing through sale of federal financial assets and reactions to VA office handling of veterans and their loans. Also includes discussion on moving the veterans' home insurance program to HUD and use by Veterans of the beach at Gulfport, Miss.
