This series contains materials concerning American Indians, their welfare, lands, and resources. In particular, the series contains materials outlining initiatives and a legislative agenda to address unemployment, education, poverty, protection of trust land, state jurisdiction over American Indians, enforcement of treaty rights, and completion of Indian claims cases. There is also correspondence from the Department of the Interior and the National Congress of American Indians concerning these and other issues. The series also contains background material for Executive Order 11435 returning civil and criminal jurisdiction over Indian country from the states to the Federal government.

The series contains materials concerning public housing for American Indians, a summary of Bureau of Indian Affairs construction programs, and the issue of employing American Indians, called forced account employment, versus contract employment on projects designed to benefit Indian tribes. There is also correspondence from tribal representatives conveying their reaction to a proposed transfer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs from the Department of the Interior to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

The series contains background information gathered in preparation for meetings between the President and various Indian tribes and interest groups.
