INSURANCE (IS)

This subject contains material pertaining to health, life, accident, surgical or hospital insurance; war risk and war damage insurance; annuities and disability retirement; and workmen's and unemployment insurance.
2' 2" (7-1/4" restricted).

Material pertaining to railroad retirement is filed in LA 9. Material pertaining to social security, old age and survivors benefits, and social welfare benefits is filed in WE 6.

IS INSURANCE.

Material concerned with a possible governmental study or commission on automobile insurance; recommendations of the National Advisory Panel on Riot Affected Areas; insurance problems and suggested changes in insurance laws. There is a great deal of cross reference material in this file. [Filed in EX IS, 9/16/64, is a copy of the Comptroller General's report to Congress on "unnecessary costs to the Government for insurance on Government-owned inventories and special tooling held by contractors under negotiated fixed price contracts"], 2". (7 items restricted).

IS 1 ACCIDENT - HOSPITAL - MEDICAL - HEALTH (MEDICARE PROGRAM). (opened 10/73)

Material pertaining to medicare, medicaid, proposals for "kiddycare," cost of medical care, health insurance abuses, compensation for government employees injured on the job, and accident insurance. The majority of documents relate to medicare legislation, implementation and operation of the program, opposition to and approval of the program, premium rates, standards for hospitals by medicare patients. The general file contains correspondence with the public relating to medicare and to problems with private health insurance. [Filed in GEN IS 1, 1/22/65, is a Mike Manatos memo relating to medicare legislation], 1' 1". (6 items restricted).

IS 1/MC ACCIDENT - HOSPITAL - MEDICAL - HEALTH / MEETINGS & CONFERENCES. (opened 10/73)

Material pertaining to the President's Meeting on Medicare Implementation, June 15, 1966. The general file also contains a file of correspondence about the writer's personal problems with medicare, 2".

IS 1-1 DISABILITY - WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION.

The executive file contains material on the quicker processing of workmen's compensation benefits; and memoranda about the Task Force on Workmen's Disability Income. The entire general file, consisting of decisions on federal government disability claims, is restricted, 1-1/2". (1-1/4" restricted).

IS 1-2 FEDERAL EMPLOYEES.

The executive file contains material on Executive Order 11160; and the Federal Employees Compensation Act Amendments of 1966. The entire general file, consisting of case files and decisions based on the Federal Employees Compensation Act, is restricted. [Filed in EX IS 1-2, 8/22/64, is a copy of the Comptroller General's report to Congress on "the loss of revenue to the Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance Fund resulting from the use of an improper premium rate for District of Columbia Government school teachers"], 1-3/4". (1-1/2" restricted).

IS 2 CROP - FARM - TENANT.

The executive file was not used. The general file contains one original document on the Federal Crop Insurance Program, -1". (1 item restricted).

IS 3 DISASTER.

Material concerned with possible congressional action relating to disaster insurance; and views on present disaster insurance coverage. [Filed EX IS 3, 3/18/66, is the report of the Task Force on Federal Flood Control Policy], 1-1/2". (1 item restricted).

IS 4 FIRE - MARINE.

The entire executive file consists of cross reference material. The general file contains two original documents relating to fire insurance policies, -1".

IS 5-2 VETERANS SERVICE.

Material concerned with dividend payments on veterans insurance and the possibility of increasing the amount of life insurance available to servicemen in Viet Nam. This file contains a great deal of cross reference material to LE/IS 5-2 and LE/VA.. The entire general file, consisting of material relating to decisions on veteran's insurance cases, is restricted, 2-1/4". (2" restricted).

IS 6 SURETY - BANK DEPOSITS.

The executive file consists of cross reference material. The entire general file consisting of decisions on funds placed in the closed San Francisco National Bank is restricted, 1-3/8". (1-1/4" restricted).

UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION.

Material pertaining to unemployment insurance claims; Federal Standards bill for unemployment insurance; and the Department of Labor's proposed unemployment insurance program for 1968, 3/4". (6 items restricted).
