Scope and content note:

The category "Medals - Awards" is used for material pertaining to medals, awards and trophies and those awarded in the name of the President which are intended to preserve the remembrance of a notable event, or of an illustrious person, or to serve as a reward, tribute, honor or acclaim.

The majority of the correspondence and memoranda in this series concern plans for striking gold and silver medallions to commemorate the Chamizal Treaty signing ceremony. Also included are memoranda concerning the distribution of the 20 gold and 380 silver Chamizal medals and copies of the letters accompanying these medals. The series contains return correspondence from recipients of the Chamizal Commemorative Medal and recipients of the Chamizal Settlement Plaque expressing gratitude.

The series also contains correspondence requesting the President's presence at festivals and awards ceremonies, requesting changes of geographic names from the Board of Geographic Names, establishing scholarships, and suggesting awards for individuals. There are also memoranda from aides asking the President's permission to accept awards from foreign governments. Later files contain memoranda concerning an Executive Order "Establishing the Meritorious Service Medal", and James Webb's offer to lecture at the LBJ Library, correspondence concerning the possibility of the Memphis Sesquicentennial medal being the first commemorative medal struck in the new Philadelphia mint, and correspondence concerning the presentation ceremony for the medal commemorating Walt Disney.

[Note from WHCF manual: "formerly known as Medals of Freedom" Correspondence from recipients of the Presidential Medal of Freedom expressing gratitude to the President, including diplomat Ralph J. Bunche; Congressman Carl Vinson, author E.B. White, swim coach and member of the President's Council on Physical Fitness Robert J. H. Kiphuth, (etc etc etc) as well as materials related to the planning of the December 6, 1963, awards ceremony; correspondence nominating people for the medal; there is also correspondence with John W. Macy, Civil Service Commissioner concerning administration of the nomination process and the Distinguished Civilian Service Awards Board; he also sent the president a report comparing the distribution of the 1963, 1964, and 1968 award recipients; programs from the September 14, 1964, presentation of the Presidential Medals of Freedom, and the December 6, 1963 planned presentation (program says "not used 12/6/63, medals presented to this group 1/28/64"); plans and arrangements for the ceremonies, including seating charts; correspondence concerning the formation of the President's Committee on the Medal of Freedom and related correspondence concerning a proposed Executive Order concerning the continuation of the Medal of Freedom and the establishment of the President's Committee on the Medal of Freedom; the text of some citations can be found here.
