The general file consists of a large amount of public opinion mail on recommendations for the 1964 vice presidential nominees. The following have specific subdivisions in this general file: Edmund Brown, Thomas Dodd, Robert Kennedy, Eugene McCarthy, Robert McNamara, Edmund Muskie, Republicans for Johnson (1964), Abraham Ribicoff, F. D. Roosevelt, Jr., Sargent Shriver, Adlai Stevenson and Robert Wagner. 8' ½".

<u>Note to the researcher</u>: There is some overlap between this category and the following categories subdivided by individual name. The separation was probably made originally on the basis of the importance of the candidates or because too much material developed to file in the PL/A-Z category.
