Biographical sketch:

John Thomas Conner (1914-2000) was appointed Secretary of Commerce by President Lyndon B. Johnson in 1965. He resigned in January 1967 to become president of Allied Chemical Corporation.

Scope and content note:

This collection contains documents regarding John T. Connor's participation in the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs Administrative History Project of the Johnson Presidency in 1977 and his participation in the 1964 presidential campaign. The collection also includes copies of correspondence regarding Connor's Merck holdings when he was nominated by Lyndon Johnson as Secretary of Commerce (1964).
