Biographical sketch:

Charles Edward Rhett's was an attorney who maintained a private law practice specializing in labor law, but also held numerous positions within the U.S. government including: Associate Solicitor, Department of Labor; Executive Assistant, War Production Board; Special Assistant to the Attorney General and Acting Attorney General, Department of Justice. He also served as U.S. Ambassador to Liberia from 1962 to 1964.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of a copy of the Rhett's Report along with pertinent correspondence. The Rhett's Report contains information written by Ed Rhett's to the U.S. Attorney General Francis Biddle on the Detroit race riots of June 1943.
