## Biographical sketch:

Charles Edward Rhetts was an attorney who maintained a private law practice specializing in labor law, but also held numerous positions within the U.S. government including: Associate Solicitor, Department of Labor; Executive Assistant, War Production Board; Special Assistant to the Attorney General and Acting Attorney General, Department of Justice. He also served as U.S Ambassador to Liberia from 1962 to 1964.

This collection consists of a copy of the Rhetts Report along with pertinent correspondence. The Rhetts Report contains information written by Ed Rhetts to the U.S. Attorney General Francis Biddle on the Detroit race riots of June 1943.
