Organizational sketch:

The Rotary Club of Austin was founded April 6, 1913. The Rotary Club is involved in the local and international community, promoting literacy, fostering access to higher education, and improving world health.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of two Western Union telegrams addressed to Lyndon Johnson and Richard Nixon along with letters of response. The first telegram is addressed to Lyndon Johnson welcoming him home and thanking him for his years of service. The second is addressed to Richard Nixon congratulating him and sending best wishes as he assumes the Presidency. Both telegrams are dated 22 January 1969. Also included are two letters sent to the Rotary Club, one from Lyndon Johnson dated 28 January 1969 and the second, from Richard Nixon (undated), both thanking them for the telegrams.
