Creator: Singer, Kurt D., 1911-

Biographical sketch:

Kurt Singer was an author, editor, journalist, lecturer, as well as an anti-Nazi activist and spy during World War II. He was born in Vienna, Grew up in Berlin, and immigrated to the U.S. via Stockholm after a bounty was placed on him in Germany. He wrote works on espionage, crime, the supernatural, and biographies. In 1955 he founded B.P. Singer Features, Inc., a syndicated international news service based in Anaheim, California with his wife Jane Sherrod.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of copies of nationally syndicated feature articles from Anaheim, California-based B.P. Singer Features, Inc. on topics ranging from boyhood friends of Lyndon B. Johnson to secrets of success compiled from 10 admired women, including Lady Bird Johnson.
