Biographical sketch:

Bernard Norwood served as an international economist at the State Department, was the First Secretary of the United States Mission to European Communities, and Assistant Chief of Commercial Policy and Treaties Division at the Department State. Norwood served as an adviser to Governor Christian A. Herter, Special Representative for Trade Negotiations, on matters relating to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, and as Chairman of the Interagency Trade Staff Committee.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, reports, and publications collected by economist Bernard Norwood covering his professional activities within the State Department and the Executive Office of the President. The papers contain materials on international trade, tariffs, legislation, and international economic relations.
