Biographical sketch:

Lynda Bird Johnson Robb is the oldest daughter of Lyndon B. Johnson and Lady Bird Johnson. She married Charles S. Robb and served as the First Lady of Virginia from 1982 to 1986. She has worked as a writer for McCall's Magazine, contributing editor to Ladies Home Journal, and lecturer and board of director of the Lyndon B. Johnson Family Foundation. She also served with the Reading is Fundamental program as a lecturer, board member, and National Chair.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of papers collected by Presidential daughter and First Lady of Virginia Lynda Robb. The papers include condolence letters to Mrs. Robb after the death of her mother Lady Bird Johnson, along with scrapbooks containing photographs of Lyndon B. and Lady Bird Johnson, Mrs. Robb, her family, and the Lyndon B.
