Biographical sketch:

Wilson D. McCarthy was a journalist and author who served as an aide to Presidents John F. Kennedy and Lyndon B. Johnson.

Andrew Tobias is an author, mainly on financial and business topics, who served as the Treasurer for the Democratic National Committee from 1999 until 2017.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, reports, publications, lists, notes, and newspaper clippings collected by Andrew Tobias. The papers originally belonged to Wilson D. McCarthy who worked for the Peace Corps and served as an aide to John F. Kennedy and Lyndon B. Johnson. The files cover issues related to Presidential campaigns, travel, and events including scheduling, itinerary, venues, logistics, transportation, publicity, guests, and attendees, as well as the 1960 and 1964 elections. The papers also include materials covering the staffing, policies, organization, and activities of the Peace Corps.
