Scope and content note:

This collection includes files maintained in Walter Jenkins' safe regarding the pre-presidential period of Lyndon B. Johnson. Most of the subjects covered by the file are topics which were controversial and involved substantial publicity for Johnson. Although the file contains a few of Johnson's personal financial records as well as a few Vice Presidential papers, the bulk of the series concerns Johnson's campaigns, particularly 1941 and 1948, legislation matters, natural resources, and political affairs. Individuals mentioned or corresponded with include Billie Sol Estes, George Parr, Robert G. (Bobby) Baker, Charles Marsh, and Clint Murchison. A particularly noteworthy set of files, those pertaining to the re-burial of the remains of Felix Longoria, are also included.
