Rusk: Question whether Lodge should say struggle movement is infested
with communists -- Rusk opposed.

McNamara: Struggle movement may be too strong to throw off. We'
don't know much about their objectives. They obviously have strength
we didn't know about, and I don't want to go to war against them.

Vice President: Agree with McNamara. Too uncertain to judge who
will line up on top.
