SUBJECT: Meeting of Guyana Prime Minister Burnham with
the President, Friday, July 26, 1968 - 5:30 p.m.


Prime Minister Forbes Burnham, accompanied by Ambassador John Carter, paid a courtesy call on the President. Assistant Secretary Oliver was also present.

After an exchange of greetings the Prime Minister



The President inquired about the outlook for the elections in Guyana. The Prime Minister expressed optimism. While no date has been set for the election, he thought it would be in early December.

The President, mentioning his interest in regional integration, asked the Prime Minister how he saw the Caribbean Development Bank shaping up. The Prime Minister



The President said he would like to be as helpful to Guyana as he could. He told the Prime Minister he would give careful consideration to any proposals he wished to make. Mr. Burnham thanked him for his understanding and willingness to support him.
