### Scope and content note:

This series contains the records of the Sports Working Group, U.S. Section of the United States-Mexico Commission for Border Development and Friendship, chaired by former Massachusetts governor Endicott Peabody. The records of this series illustrate the activities of officials from national, state, and local governments, as well as citizens on both sides of the U.S.-Mexican border, to strengthen relations between the two countries through athletic programs and competitions, primarily at the high school and college levels.

The documents in the series consist mostly of American officials' correspondence among themselves, with their Mexican counterparts, and with private citizens and entities involved in the promotion of athletics in the border area, which was divided into 12 zones from the Pacific Ocean to the Gulf of Mexico. Most of these letters, memorandums, and telegrams concern administrative matters connected with staging events, such as securing venues, making travel arrangements, and arranging for publicity. Other records pertaining to the Sports Working Group's activities include clippings from newspapers on both sides of the border, and information about athletic organizations and camps in each country.

There is also material about the Commission's goals and other aspects of its work on border issues, and about the 1968 Olympics (held in Mexico City), the threatened boycott by black athletes, and the protest by two black medalists during the presentation of their awards.
