### Scope and content note:

This collection contains files that Fred Panzer created as Staff Assistant to President Lyndon Baines Johnson. Panzer joined the White House staff as a detail from the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare (HEW), and worked under Special Assistants Bill Moyers, Robert Kintner, and Marvin Watson. Following Watson's departure, Panzer reported directly to the President until the close of the Administration. Panzer's office performed research and provided a continuous flow of information to the President, Cabinet members, others members of the White House staff, the Democratic National Committee, and members of Congress about public opinion, government programs, statistics, and a broad variety of topics.

The files contain materials related to polls, legislation, Federal programs, and information on US government agencies and the Johnson Administration. They include correspondence, memoranda, reports, speech drafts, opinion polls, press releases, telephone logs, invitations, newspaper clippings, bound volumes, and other printed material.
