#### **Scope and content note:**

This series contains the working files of NSC staff member Charles E. Johnson. Other specific subjects included in this series are communications satellites; nuclear weapons and nuclear testing including the nuclear test ban treaty; marine science and oceanology; and U.S. Trust Territories.

#### **Biographical note:**

Charles E. Johnson was a member of the NSC Staff from 1962 through the close of the Johnson Administration. He divided his time between the NSC, the AEC, and NASA. This collection consists of files concerning scientific matters, space matters, weaponry, arms control, and atomic energy. The files comprise only a part of Johnson's subject file. The LBJ Library did not receive the rest of the folders and has not succeeded in locating them.
