Scope and content note:

Spurgeon Keeny was a part-time senior member of the NSC staff from 1963 to 1969. He divided his time between the NSC and the Office of Science and Technology. His areas of responsibility were military technology and arms control.

This series includes correspondence, memorandums, meeting minutes, notes, telegrams, agendas, press releases, and reports concerning atomic energy (nuclear energy), desalting, disarmament, denuclearized zones (nuclear-weapon-free zones), nuclear weapons, the non-proliferation treaty, and anti-ballistic missiles. In addition, there are memorandums of conversations with Anatoly Dobrynin and Andrei Gromyko. There is also information concerning military and nuclear technology related to Great Britain, China, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Egypt, France, Germany, and Greece.

Processing note:

These files comprise only a part of Keeny's alphabetically arranged subject file. The LBJ Library did not receive the rest of the folders and has not succeeded in locating them.
