#### **Scope and content note:**

This series contains National Security Action Memorandums (NSAM) and their supporting material including correspondence, reports, and memorandums. NSAMs were documents issued by Presidents John F. Kennedy and Lyndon B. Johnson or by their national security advisors to Federal agencies to either relay policy statements or to request action programs. Topics covered in the NSAMs and their supporting material include U.S. national security policy; nuclear energy, weapons, and arms control; foreign military, economic, and food aid; international trade; outer space, including communications satellites; U.S. military weapons; and NATO. All geographic regions are reflected in the series, but specific countries include Vietnam, Cuba, Panama, India, Pakistan, and Indonesia.
