Scope and content note:

This series contains correspondence, reports, and maps collected by Lieutenant General Arthur G. Trudeau during his service as director of Army research and development and after his retirement from the Army. A small portion of the series is related to the development of military weapons and equipment. The bulk of the series is related to Mr. Trinh-Hung-Ngau and the Vietnam War. Trinh was a Vietnamese nationalist who frequently corresponded with American officials relaying his opinions on the situation in Vietnam.
