The White House Press Office facilitated relations between the media and the President. This office, and the role of the Press Secretary, evolved as the President's need for an intermediary between himself and the press increased. The Press Secretary is appointed by the President with no specified term of office.

The researcher should note the following definitions to assist him in understanding the operation of the Press Office.

PRESS BRIEFING: usually covers routine or only moderately important news. The exception to this is when the meeting is off-the-record. At a normal briefing, the press release is given to the reporters, the Press Secretary discusses the announcement or report, and the reporters then ask questions.

PRESS SECRETARY NEWS CONFERENCE: these sessions usually involved a high-ranking official or other well known person and the information is on-the-record.

ON-THE-RECORD: all statements made by an official can be attributed to him by name.

BACKGROUND: the statements must be attributed to "a government official" , "White House source" etc.

DEEP BACKGROUND: statements cannot be attributed to anybody, no direct quotes can be used, must use terms like "it is understood that".

OFF-THE-RECORD: the information cannot be printed or broadcast at all.

BACK-UP MATERIAL: this consists of information compiled for the President to prepare him for possible questions during a press conference, including some classified material.

This collection is arranged into series by document type. Most of the series are arranged in a numbered or chronological sequence, with some arranged alphabetically by name or subject.

A few of the series contain duplications. For example, in Press Secretary's News Conferences - one series is made up of mimeographed copies that were given to the Press, and one set is

typed/carbons (before being mimeographed). The mimeographed copies are generally clearer and more suitable for copying.

These papers are both the finished product of the White House Press Office endeavors and the working papers of the Press Office. Related material may be found in the White House Central File under PR 8, PR 18 and FG-11-8-1/name of Press Secretary. The following oral histories are relevant to the Press Office files: George Reedy AC 74-239, George Christian, Drew Pearson, Chalmers Roberts, and Robert S. Allen.

INDEX CARDS

There are two sets of index cards which were made by the White House Staff. The larger set is for the Press Secretary's News Conferences. This is an alphabetical index to key words from the conference. The researcher should be aware that many times very minor words were indexed, so be creative in trying to find references to your topic.

The smaller set of index cards is for Press Releases. This index is chronological by month and year. Within each month, there is a set of A-Z cards which indexes the names of appointees for that month. There is also a set of topic cards common to each month, such as Proclamations, Messages, trips, visitors, etc.

PROCESSING NOTES

The collection was removed from storage boxes and placed in acid free folders and boxes. Preservation copying was done where appropriate.

When an inventory was first made of the collection, the archives technician noted that some of the George Reedy material did not belong with the Press Office Files. Hence, this material was removed and made part of the Reedy Aides Files. Also as a result of this inventory, the library disposed of over 165 record center boxes containing duplicates and old empty folders.

The Working Files series was in disarray, with folders in no discernable order and much of the correspondence just loose in the boxes. The processing archivist created an order and organized the correspondence chronologically.

Using the Background Briefings Subject File list for individual years, the processing archivist compiled a single alphabetical listing.

Box 78 contains a folder titled "November 17, 1967 [removed from notebook]". Prior to the processing of this collection, this notebook was removed and certain documents were used for exhibit in the museum. When the notebook was returned it was misfiled into the Cabinet Papers. During processing, the error was discovered and the contents of the notebook have now been returned to the proper location in box 78 of the Press Office Files. A note was placed in the folder re those documents removed for exhibit.
