#### Scope and content note:

Material in this category pertains to a country, continent, or geographic area; and foreign governments, their officials and ambassadors. The file is arranged first by geographic areas and then beginning with CO 10 alphabetically by country with each country assigned a sequential number.

This category was used primarily for visits of heads of state and chiefs of government and for cross referencing, mainly in the following categories:

CA 7 - approval of CAB orders regarding foreign air carrier permits.

**GI** - memoranda regarding the exchange of gifts during heads of state visits and on President's trips to foreign countries; Luci Johnson's wedding thank you notes; and the sending of space exploration photographs to foreign government officials by President Johnson.

**HO** - exchange of messages on U.S. and foreign holidays.

**HU 2/MC** - thank you letters to the President from those receiving copies of the Final Report of the White House Conference "To Fulfill These Rights."

**IM** - requests for assistance with immigration status, especially visas.

**ME** - miscellaneous messages exchanged between the President and heads of state, government officials, and ambassadors.

ND 21 - carbons of invitations to the 7/1/68 signing of the Non-Proliferation Treaty.

**OS** - messages from foreign countries congratulating the U.S. on successful space missions.

**PP and PP 1** - messages congratulating the President on 1964 election and expressing condolences following deaths of Douglas MacArthur, Adlai Stevenson, Herbert Hoover, U.S. astronauts, John F. Kennedy, Robert F. Kennedy, and Martin Luther King, Jr.

PR - requests for autographed photographs.

TR - Presidential trips to foreign countries.

Material on head of state visits filed in CO usually consists of Department of State Protocol Office administrative arrangements for the visit, including announcements, schedules, ceremonies, transportation, background material, guest lists, itineraries, press arrangements and press coverage, biographies of the official party, dinner toasts, expressions of appreciation and reactions to the visit.
