Riding back from Middleburg, Senator Johnson discussed several subjects and among them the Civil Rights fight now in progress in the Senate. Senator Johnson referred to a speech Senator Russell made in which Russell described the Senator procedure as "legislative lynching." Senator Johnson said it had occurred to him to reply to Russell that this was the only kind of lynching he, Johnson, had ever heard Russell object to. But Senator Johnson said he had decided against it because "you might win an argument but lose the sale and you might not even win the argument." See next page of notes.
