Senator Johnson said he didn't know how the Senate would ever get to a vote on the Civil Rights Bill. He thought that this issue would "destroy me." When asked if Senator Russell did not know this, he replied, "He doesn't care." Senator Johnson said that "History will record that this was my greatest tactical error." When asked what else could he have done, he replied, that he should have let someone else motion up the bill.
