At 4:00 pm today the Speaker, John Connally, Oscar Chapman and Mrs. India Edwards held a press conference at the Speaker's office to announce the opening of the Citizens for Johnson for President Committee headquarters. Senator Johnson was very much opposed to opening the headquarters and to the press conference. He would have preferred that the headquarters, if any, just be operated from a hotel room -- "like Lucius Clay did for Eisenhower." Senator Johnson referred to himself as another "Warren Harding."
