Biographical sketch:

Retired Rear Admiral James Duncan Enoch, D.D.S., M.S. (b. March 13, 1927, Nashville, Tennessee - d. September 14, 2014, Viera, Florida) served in the U.S. Navy beginning in 1945, leaving service in 1946 to attend college and returning to the Navy in 1957. Among his many tours of duty, he served an additional duty to the White House as the dentist to the President of the United States.

In 1974, Dr. Enoch became Commanding Officer at the Naval Regional Dental Center, Great Lakes, Illinois, with additional duties as Director of Dental Activities, and Dental Reserve Program Officer, Ninth Naval District and later served as Head of the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery, Planning and Logistics Branch, Dental Division, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery, in Washington, D.C. In 1980, Enoch became the Chief of the Navy Dental Corps, and Assistant Chief for Dentistry of the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery.

Scope and content note:

The Personal Papers of Rear Admiral James Enoch contain materials reflecting Enoch's duties as dentist to President Johnson, Lady Bird Johnson, and Vice President Humphrey. This collection includes correspondence, dental records, treatment plans, and other material related to the dental services provided by Enoch to the First Family and others at the White House.
