#### Biographical sketch:

Cynthia E. Wilson worked for the White House Social Correspondence Office and with the First Lady's White House Beautification Project under Lady Bird Johnson. After leaving the White House, she worked with Stewart Udall and Governor Castro of New Mexico, as well as for the National Audubon Society and the Department of the Interior.

#### Scope and content note:

The papers of Cynthia E. Wilson, a member of Mrs. Johnson's White House staff, include a photocopy of the notebook used to draft letters for Mrs. Johnson concerning beautification. It also contains White House photographs, newspaper clippings, and correspondence reflecting Cynthia Wilson's involvement with beautification and her relationship with Lady Bird Johnson.
