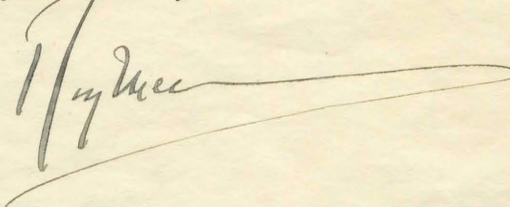
Dear Lupe:
