His Newspapering Runs In Family (Both Sides)

THE DEEP, DARK SECRET of why Walter Max Wade is a newspaper publisher is one of the simplest secrets yet. A few of his forebears were printers and newspapermen.

Take, for instance, on his father's side of the family. Dad Wade, was the Rev. W. J. Wade, a Baptist minister who also owned and published five weekly newspapers in as many different towns in Texas and New Mexico. Then there were four uncles on his father's side who followed the printing trade, which led Max a little closer to newspapering.

On his mother's side of the family—mother, of course, helped Dad Wade with the five weeklies, to begin with, but she also had ten cousins who were printers. You just might say that Max had two strikes on him when he started life, and then the pitcher walked him to first base 25 years ago at Groom, where he still publishes the **Groom News**, the last newspaper his father published before he passed away in 1928.

Born October 24, 1911, in Coleman County, Texas, which was the first highlight in his life, Max says other highlights come each week when "the newspaper is in the mail."

Max's life was typical of the son of a minister. The family lived progres-

sively at Coleman, Aspermont, Jayton (all in Texas), then moved to Hope, N.M., Artesia, N. M., back to Texas at Lubbock, Amarillo, Pampa, Borger and to Groom.

After he took over the **Groom News** on the death of his father, he was "off and on" the publisher, selling, then buying back the same newspaper several times.

He spent two years in the armed forces during World War II, "traveling in England, France and Germany" on special "conducted tours" of the U. S. Army.

Besides publishing the **Groom** newspaper, Max has been a Lino-type operator at Jayton, Artesia, Carlsbad, Pampa, Borger, Amarillo and Lubbock for about 12 years of the past 24. Most of his jobs were a "return to boyhood scenes" where his father had published and preached.

The first publisher of the **Groom News** was E. Pate Reavis, from whom the elder Wade bought it in December 1927. The publication at that time was about a year and nine months old, having been established in March, 1926.

"The nicest yardstick I know to

measure the place of a newspaper in its community is whether or not subscriptions are renewed regularly. I am happy that the people of Groom show their appreciation of our policy and effort in that way," Max says, describing the progress of the publication as exactly parallel with the community's growth.

The **Groom News** is presently located in its own building, where a well-equipped shop turns out a well-accepted weekly newspaper having good reader interest and well-established public relations.

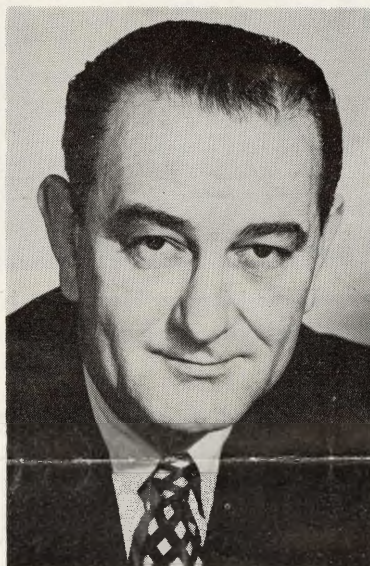
Asked about his particular working habits, Max quipped: "Let's not be funny," and went on to say that if he were not in the newspaper business he would like nothing better than to do "nothing for a long time."

He says his main interests other than the publication of his newspaper are in entertaining children, including his own three daughters.

He actively dislikes sports, except to watch an occasional high school football game.

Newspapering in Texas, according to Max, has "turned from a shirttail full of type and a press into fairly well-equipped and edited newspapers which have a definite place in the community life, working constantly for improvement and development of the towns and state. They are better established, more financially able, more independent than ever before," he thinks.

You have asked me to comment on the provisions of law (Texas Election Code) pertaining to expenditures by individuals in behalf of candidates for office.

First, I direct your attention to paragraph (b) of Section 240, Chapter 14, Texas Election Code. It is as follows:

"It shall be lawful for any person to expend a sum which shall not in the aggregate exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) for postage, or telegraph or telephone tolls, or for costs of any correspondence, or any other lawful purpose out of his own funds to aid or defeat any candidate, where the sum is not to be repaid to him."

The effect of this paragraph is to limit to \$25 the amount which an individual may expend, other than by contribution to the candidate, to aid or defeat a candidate. This does not mean that 2 or more persons, acting together, are limited to \$25. Two persons, for example, may join together and pay for a radio broadcast, printing, or a newspaper ad, the total cost of which does not exceed \$50 so long as the expenditure by neither exceeds \$25. Likewise, 3 persons may pay for an item costing not more than \$75, and so on. In this connection, the revisers note on paragraph (b) states:

"The aggregate amount which a person may spend out of his own funds has been increased from \$10 to \$25. The intent of paragraph (b) is to restrict the aggregate expenditure by an individual on behalf of a candidate, other than by contribution to the candidate, to \$25. It was not intended to prohibit two or more persons from joining together to pay for a single item of expense--for example, a newspaper advertisement or a radio broadcast--so long as no one person exceeds

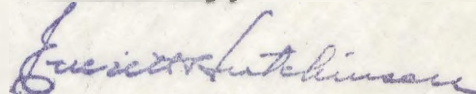
his individual aggregate total of \$25 for that and all other purposes during the campaign. The limitation of \$25 in paragraph (b) does not apply to paragraph (c)." Texas Election Laws, Price Daniel, Attorney General of Texas, 1952, p. 177.

Second, under paragraph (c) of Section 240 a person may contribute his personal services and traveling expenses to aid a candidate without regard to the limitation contained in paragraph (b) above. The "amount" limitation contained in paragraph (b) does not apply to paragraph (c). See the Reviser's note above.

In addition to contributing their own time and efforts, numerous supporters throughout the State no doubt will want to aid your campaign during the closing week by paying for small ads, radio announcements, and similar items. This is permissible under the statute and is certainly proper provided no individual expends more than \$25. If you have inquiries from any of your friends concerning this, I think it would be wise to fully advise them about the provisions of paragraph (b) so they can keep any such expenditures within the letter and intent of the Election Code. I recommend that you do this as a safeguard and to protect your candidacy because all those interested in helping in this way may not know that \$25 is all one person can spend.
