Mr. LYNDON B. JOHNSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Expenditures in the Executive Departments

A BILL

To amend sections 13 (f) and 16 of the Surplus Property Act of 1944, with respect to the disposition of property to veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 13 (f) of the Act of October 3, 1944, the
4 Surplus Property Act of 1944, is amended to read as follows:

5 “(f) The disposal of surplus property under this sec-
6 tion to States and political subdivisions and instrumentalities
7 thereof shall be given priority over all other disposals of
8 property provided for in this Act except transfers under
9 sections 12 and 16.”

10 That section 16 of the Act of October 3, 1944, the Sur-

1 plus Property Act of 1944, is amended to read as follows:

2 "DISPOSITIONS TO VETERANS

3 "SEC. 16. The Administrator shall prescribe regula-
4 tions permitting veterans to acquire appropriate amounts
5 of surplus property for their own use or to enable them to
6 establish and maintain their own small business, professional
7 or agricultural enterprises, and dispositions of surplus prop-
8 erty to veterans under this section shall be given priority
9 over all other disposals of property provided for in this Act,
10 except transfers to Government agencies under section 12."
