Scope and content note:

This series contains memorandums, correspondence, reports, lists, clippings, meeting notes, telegrams related to a broad range of intelligence issues, and intelligence reports on a wide variety of issues. Some of the topics in this series include nuclear issues such as nuclear energy, nuclear security, nuclear tests, nuclear weapons, and the test ban treaty; military intelligence; air and satellite reconnaissance; anti-missile defense; guerilla warfare; foreign elections; budgets; peace groups; student unrest; espionage; biological tests; defections, including that of Joseph Stalin's daughter, Svetlana Alliluyeva; presidential trips; arms control; outer space; the 303 Committee; the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board (PFIAB); Lee Harvey Oswald; Walter Jenkins; and peace negotiations.

In addition, there is also material related to the Tonkin Gulf incident in 1964 and the capture of the USS Pueblo in 1968. Some of the geographic regions included in this series are Latin America, Vietnam, India, Korea, Greece, the Soviet Union, China, and the Middle East. This series contains correspondence from Dean Rusk, Henry Cabot Lodge, and William Bundy.
